 Subject: Notification to Parents of Teacher Qualifications

As a parent of a student at *Texans Can! School*, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child, and Federal law requires the school district to provide you this information. According to the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 [P.L. 107-110, Section 9505(23)], a highly qualified teacher is one who:

- Has obtained a Bachelor's degree;
- Has demonstrated competency in the subject area assigned to teach;
- Has obtained full State certification as a teacher or has passed the State teacher licensing examination; and
- Has not had certification or licensure requirements waived on an emergency, temporary, or provisional basis.

You also have the right to know whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.

This notice is to inform you of the qualifications of the classroom teachers and paraprofessionals who instruct your child.
